The Military Share program delivers fresh, nutritious foods to individuals and families who are food insecure and meet income requirements. At least one member of the household must have served or is serving in the Armed Forces or National Guard.

The first distribution will take place at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds, located at 1514 State Route 28, Brookville, Pennsylvania, 15825. It is a first come, first served food distribution in a drive-thru format.

Food insecurity is defined as lacking reliable access to enough affordable, nutritious food. According to the latest Map the Meal Gap statistics from Feeding America, 88,670 individuals in Northwest Pennsylvania are food insecure.
