Second Harvest celebrates 40 years in the community!

The seeds of our food bank were planted in 1982, when the Erie Community Food Bank was formed under the leadership of Sister Augusta Hamel, OSB, at the old Curtze Warehouse located on East 21st Street. With increased donations, a new 29,000 square foot warehouse was found the following year at 1703 Ash Street to accommodate those in need.

In 1983, the Erie Community Food Bank became a member of the Second Harvest National Network along with 39 other food banks across the United States. In 1985, the Erie Community Food Bank was recognized as a national leader in food banking for computerized record keeping and having a well-equipped facility.

In 1990, the Erie Community Food Bank was renamed Second Harvest Food Bank of Northwest Pennsylvania to better represent its service area. In 1993, Suzanne Cascio was appointed the new Executive Director of the food bank.

As food banking services continued to expand in our region, Karen Seggi became Executive Director in 2001. Under her guidance, a new facility was purchased in 2008 on Grimm Drive in Erie to expand our warehouse capacity to 60,000 square feet. A fleet of trucks were soon on the road to deliver to those who were food insecure.

Today, Second Harvest provides food to those in need in 11 counties of northwest Pennsylvania while creating awareness and educating the community on the realities of hunger. Our vision remains steadfast for a hunger-free community as we commemorate our 40 years of food banking!



- (D) Change in Investments & Assets: (\$1,243,539)




Expenses

Child Feeding Programs

For many children, school breakfasts and lunches may be the only meals they consistently receive. To ensure these children receive proper nutrition on the weekend, the Second Harvest BackPack Program provides nutritious, child-friendly foods on Fridays each week during the school year. The Second Harvest School Pantry Program provides food and other necessities to these children and their families in safe, familiar locations within their school.

Produce Express

Our Produce Express Program delivers food directly to clients when traditional food pantries may not be available. This program provides fresh, healthy produce, and shelf stable items to those who normally would not have access to it. Second Harvest continues to encourage healthier eating and better nutritional choices by offering a variety of items.

Military Share

Military Share, a Produce Express Program, is designed to provide fresh, nutritious foods for families with at least one member who is currently serving or has served in the Armed Forces.

PA Senior Food Box Program

The U.S.D.A. provides food items for distribution to low-income seniors to supplement what they can purchase on their own or receive from other food assistance programs.

Healthy Pantry Initiative

The PA Healthy Pantry Initiative (HPI) equips our food pantries with the tools they need to become a community resource for promoting healthy food choices and nutrition education. The program aims to combat chronic disease and improve the health of pantry clients.

Food Rescue & MealConnect

Second Harvest Food Bank has been rescuing food since its beginning in 1982. We now rescue food from over 130 food establishments and redistribute it to hunger relief agencies in 11 different counties throughout northwest Pennsylvania. As a partner with Feeding America, we are now using their innovative MealConnect tool to orchestrate even more food rescues. This tool is designed to be a convenient, free, and safe way for businesses of any size to reduce wasted food and donate surplus meals throughout our community.

In the 2021 – 2022 fiscal year, Second Harvest had 7,144 unique donors with 13,735 gifts totaling over \$3.3 million. Gifts come in the way of grants, direct mail, fundraisers, and planned giving. Volunteer - Thank you

Volunteers are critical to the mission and success of the Second Harvest Food Bank of Northwest Pennsylvania. Our Food Bank hosted an average of 114 volunteers per week and over 1,700 volunteers in total. Our selfless volunteers donated over 13,000 hours to Second Harvest in the 2021-22 fiscal year. Without volunteers, Second Harvest would have to hire at least 6 additional full-time employees to cover the time and work donated each year.
