Volunteer Project Lead

Position Summary: The Volunteer Project Lead primarily works with volunteers and coordinates the processing of salvage/distressed products, food drive donations, and other items for distribution to member agencies. This position ensures that all products are handled and stored using proper procedures.

Duties and Responsibilities include the following: This list is not all-inclusive and other duties may be assigned.

- Manage groups of volunteers at Second Harvest Food Bank and at various special events as needed.
- Ensures that volunteers meet Second Harvest criteria stated in the manual/handbook.
- Works with volunteers including weekends.
- Conducts volunteer orientation, training, and tours. Ensures that the volunteer experience is enjoyable, positive, and satisfying. Educates volunteers on how their work is helping alleviate hunger.
- Works with Warehouse Manager to determine appropriate workflow and schedule of projects.
- Assigns duties, provide materials, and supervise volunteers throughout projects.
- Follows and stays up-to-date on safe-food handling procedures. Ensures that all products are handled and stored using proper procedures.
- Adheres to guidelines of salvage operations as described in Feeding America Manual.
- Checks processed salvage (quality control).
- Ensures completion and filing of accident reports and responds appropriately.
- Ensures volunteer break room and salvage areas are maintained. Sweeps volunteer break room and work areas daily.
- Provides beverages, snacks, etc. for volunteers during assigned hours.
- Completes rework paperwork.
- Any other duties assigned by upper management.

Education and/or experience

High School Diploma required. Some post-secondary education and two to three years volunteer or human resource management experience preferred. Experience may be substituted for education.

Language skills

Must possess outstanding interpersonal and group communications skills. Ability to effectively present information and respond to questions from groups, clients, customers, and the general public.
